The Commission finds:


- (1) On October 26, 1994, Time Warner Communications of Ohio, L.P. (Time Warner) filed a petition seeking to initiate an investigation to address competitive issues associated with the provision of basic local exchange service as well as issues surrounding the appropriate parameters to guide the evolution of a competitive telecommunications marketplace.
- (2) Rather than proceed on Time Warner's petition, the Commission undertook to address issues surrounding competition of basic local exchange service and the competitive telecommunications marketplace through several rulemaking proceedings.
- (3) The Commission now finds it appropriate to close this matter of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this matter be closed of record in accordance with finding 3. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


