ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and the Toledo Edison Company (FirstEnergy or the Companies) are public utilities as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, are subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On March 23, 2010, FirstEnergy filed an application, pursuant to Section 4928.141, Revised Code, for a standard service offer for the period between June 1, 2011, and May 31, 2014. This application is for an electric security plan (ESP), in accordance with Section 4928.143, Revised Code, and the application includes a stipulation (Joint Stipulation) agreed to by various parties regarding the terms of the proposed ESP. The evidentiary hearing in this proceeding commenced on April 20, 2010.
- (3) By entry dated May 13, 2010, the Commission determined that additional information regarding the impact of the proposed ESP on customer bills is necessary for its consideration of the proposed ESP. Therefore, the Commission directed that the evidentiary hearing in this proceeding resume on June 17, 2010.
- (4) However, due to hearing room availability, the attorney examiner finds that it is necessary to reschedule the evidentiary hearing to June 21, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 E. Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-A Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the evidentiary hearing be rescheduled to June 21, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 E. Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-A Columbus, Ohio. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record in this proceeding.
