Cleveland Commercial Railroad's Contractor, Railroad Traffic Control, will not be able to complete this project by June 17, 2010 due to a delay in their supplier shipping the necessary signal equipment. The supplier, Fabricated Metals, LLC, of Louisville, KY, in turn experienced a 45 day delay when their component supplier, GE sold that division to Progressive Rail Corporation.

Mr. Curt Baldridge of Fabricated Metals has assured Mr. Kole, President of Cleveland Commercial Railroad, that the signal equipment will be shipped this week. Further, Mr. Miller of Railroad Traffic Control has assured Mr. Kole that the project will be completed prior to July 17, 2010.
