## **ENTRY**

## The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 10, 2010, A&O Investments dba Vendere Energy (Vendere Energy) filed an application for a certificate as a competitive retail electric service provider allowing it to provide aggregation and power broker services.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-24-06(A), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), Vendere's certification application is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process. Additionally, Rule 4901:1-24-06(A)(1), O.A.C., provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission or an attorney examiner may suspend consideration of a certification application.
- (3) Additional information and investigation is necessary in order to complete a review of this application. Therefore, the attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 30-day automatic approval process for Vendere's application in order that the Commission and its staff may further review this matter.
- (4) The attorney examiner notes that Rule 4901:1-24-06(A)(2)(b), O.A.C., requires that, if consideration of a certification application is suspended, the Commission must act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That consideration of Vendere's application for certification be suspended in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in this proceeding.
