On November 16, 2009 CSX requested an extension of construction regarding the subject project to June 30, 2010. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") granted the extension on December 4, 2009. The extension was requested due to the winter weather delaying the installation.

The improvements at Crocker Street, per the subsidy agreement, included the installation of a new concrete surface and relocation of the warning devices. It also stated that SR 281 (Church Street) will have a new surface installed as well. The aforementioned surfaces have been installed and signal improvements have been completed. Lightner Street will be closed this week.

The subsidy agreement also included language for the city to install barricades and curbs due to the closure of Lightner Street with CSX to reimburse the costs. This extension is requested to give the city time to install the sidewalk and permanent barricades at Lightner Street.

Due to the above mentioned issues and delays, CSX respectfully requests a construction due date extension to July 30, 2010.
