ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 18, 2009, James Struewing (complainant) filed a complaint against The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L), alleging that DP&L improperly billed him for electricity passing through a meter connected to a barn located on complainant's property. Specifically, complainant states that on approximately July 24, 2009, DP&L disconnected the barn meter, and subsequently, complainant received a bill in excess of \$7,000.00 for electricity that DP&L stated was due on the account because of improper metering over the last five years.
- (2) On December 8, 2009, DP&L filed its answer to the complaint, as well as a motion to dismiss, denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) On June 21, 2010, the parties filed a joint request to dismiss this case, stating that the parties have reached a settlement which resolves all of the issues raised in the complaint.
- (4) In light of the resolution of the complaint, the Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' request to dismiss the complaint be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 09-1819-EL-CSS be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.





