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MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

During the prehearing conference held on June 25, 2010, the attorney examiner established July 16, 2010 as the deadline for the filing of Staff's direct testimony in this rate case. Since the date of the prehearing conference, Aqua Ohio, Inc., the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, and Staff have actively engaged in settlement negotiations. The parties and Staff continue to work toward reaching a settlement agreement that would resolve all of the issues in this proceeding. For that reason, Staff requests that the deadline for filing its direct testimony be extended from July 16, 2010 to July 20, 2010.
