ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On June 29, 2010, U.S. Signal, L.L.C. dba RVP Fiber Co. (U.S. Signal) filed a complaint against The Ohio Bell Telephone Company dba AT&T Ohio (AT&T) to extend the term of an interconnection agreement.
- (2) By joint motion filed July 19, 2010, U.S. Signal and AT&T request that the date for filing an answer to the complaint be extended for 14 days from July 20, 2010, to August 3, 2010. In the motion, the parties note that July 20, 2010, is the due date for AT&T's answer. The parties explain that they expect to finalize negotiations by August 3, 2010, thus obviating the need for AT&T to file an answer. The parties note that if they reach an agreement they will file an interconnection agreement amendment in a separate docket. Upon such a filing, the parties intend to dismiss the complaint.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that the motion to extend the answer date from July 20, 2010, to August 3, 2010, is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, AT&T shall be granted until August 3, 2010, to file an answer to the complaint.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion to extend until August 3, 2010, the date for AT&T to file an answer to the complaint is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon U.S. Signal and its counsel, AT&T and its counsel, and all interested persons of record.
