3 EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: The Public
4 Utilities Commission of Ohio has set for hearing at
5 this date and time Case No. 10-505-EL-FOR, In the
6 Matter of the Long-Term Forecast Report of Dayton
7 Power & Light Company and Related Matters.

8 I am Henry Phillips-Gary. With me is
9 Gregory Price. We are attorney examiners assigned to
10 this case.

11 At this point the time we will begin by
12 taking appearances on behalf of the parties.

13 MR. GRIFFIN: I'm Randall V. Griffin on
14 behalf of the Dayton Power & Light Company.

15 EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Thank you.

16 MR. WRIGHT: Good morning, your Honor.
17 On behalf of the staff of the Public Utilities
18 Commission, Ohio Attorney General Richard Cordray,
19 I'd like to enter the appearance of Thomas W. McNamee
20 and William L. Wright, 180 East Broad Street
21 Columbus, Ohio 43215.

22 MR. REESE: Your Honor, on behalf of the
23 residential ratepayers of the Dayton Power & Light
24 Company and on behalf of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel,
25 Janine Migden Ostrander, I'm Richard C. Reese.

1 EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Thank you.

2 Are there any members of the public
3 present today?

4 (No response.)

5 EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Let the record
6 reflect there are no members of the public present
7 today.

8 Before we get started, are there any
9 preliminary matters the parties wish to bring to our
10 attention?

11 MR. GRIFFIN: Your Honor, the only thing
12 I would note is yesterday I filed with the Commission
13 and copied everyone here the certificates of
14 publication for I believe nine of the newspapers that
15 published. There's one that has published but hasn't
16 yet sent a certification, so I'll be supplementing
17 that filing at a later date.

18 EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Okay.

19 EXAMINER PRICE: Are you going to move
20 the admission of those today or do that the next
21 time?

22 MR. GRIFFIN: Whatever your preference
23 is. I am happy to move the admission right now if
24 that suits everybody.

25 I move to admit the certificates of

publication as Company Exhibit No. 1.

EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: All right. They will be so marked.

(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

MR. REESE: Your Honor, I did want to mention, I understand we are having a public hearing today. OCC does contemplate that we will still have to schedule an evidentiary hearing in this matter. I wanted to make sure we got that on the record.

EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Yes. Based on my understanding, we will set an evidentiary hearing. Based on the remarks made by the parties before we went on the record, the parties are still discussing the process and what steps the parties need to take before we have the evidentiary hearing so the evidentiary hearing will be set by subsequent entry after discussion by the parties.

MR. REESE: Thank you, your Honor.

EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Anything else we need to discuss at this point in time?

EXAMINER PHILLIPS-GARY: Did you move for admission? I heard that you are marking those so they are marked and the company has moved for admission of Company Exhibit 1. Are there any
