BY THE SOLAR ALLIANCE**


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By entry dated July 15, 2010, the Commission established a procedural schedule which included July 27, 2010 as the deadline for filing motions to intervene. Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) Rule 4901-1-12(C), the Solar Alliance moves the Commission to grant its motion to intervene one day out of time.

The Solar Alliance's motion to intervene was electronically filed on July 27, 2010, but was filed approximately eight minutes after the Commission offices closed. On behalf of the Solar Alliance, counsel respectfully asks this Commission to accept its motion to intervene. Acceptance of the Solar Alliance's motion to intervene one day out of time will not significantly delay the process in this case nor unduly burden any of the parties.
