ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 20, 2009, Ms. Mary Bajus (Ms. Bajus) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T) alleging that AT&T committed errors and omissions with respect to her Yellow Pages listing and that AT&T failed to provide an intercept message for a discontinued business telephone number.
- (2) AT&T filed an answer to the complaint on August 10, 2009. AT&T alleged that the Commission has no jurisdiction over Yellow Pages Directory listings. Overall, AT&T concluded that the complainant failed to set forth reasonable grounds for complaint pursuant to Section 4905.26, Revised Code.
- (3) By entry issued December 3, 2009, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a settlement conference. The parties convened for a conference on January 13, 2010, but were not able to reach an agreement at that time.
- (4) On July 27, 2010, AT&T filed a letter, signed by both parties, informing the Commission that the parties have reached an agreement. The parties request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (5) Being advised that the parties have reached an agreement, the parties' request shall be granted. Accordingly, the complaint shall be dismissed with prejudice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint request of the parties to dismiss the complaint with prejudice be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry be served upon the parties, counsel, and interested persons of record.
