## <u>ENTRY</u>

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 29, 2010, U.S. Signal, L.L.C. dba RVP Fiber Co. (U.S. Signal) filed a complaint against The Ohio Bell Telephone Company dba AT&T Ohio (AT&T) to extend the term of an interconnection agreement.
- (2) On August 10, 2010, the parties filed a letter advising the Commission that the parties have entered into an interconnection agreement amendment that resolves the issues raised by the complaint. The parties note that the interconnection agreement amendment has been filed in Case No. 10-1075-TP-NAG. To end this matter, the parties jointly request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (3) Finding that the parties have entered into an interconnection agreement amendment, and by doing so, have resolved the issues raised by the complaint, the Commission concludes that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint with prejudice should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, pursuant to the joint request of the parties, the complaint filed in this matter be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon U.S. Signal and its counsel, AT&T and its counsel, and all interested persons of record.
