## ENTRY

The Commission finds:
(1) On March 28, 2008, as amended on September 11, 2009, The Manchester Group, LLC, (Manchester) filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia). Manchester alleges that Columbia has refused to include Manchester's charges for warranty products and services on Columbia's customer bills; thus, Manchester maintains that it is at a competitive disadvantage because it has not been provided the same access to the customers' bills. Therefore, Manchester claims that Columbia is in noncompliance with its tariff and in violation of Sections 4905.26, 4905.32, 4905.33, and 4905.35, Revised Code.
(2) By entries issued between June 5, 2009, and May 17, 2010, the attorney examiner established and revised the procedural schedule in this case.
(3) On July 29, 2010, Manchester filed a notice of voluntary dismissal requesting that the complaint be dismissed without prejudice.
(4) By entry issued July 30, 2010, the hearing in this matter, which was scheduled for August 11, 2010, was held in abeyance pending the Commission's consideration of Manchester's July 29, 2010, request to dismiss this case.
(5) The Commission finds that Manchester's request to dismiss the complaint, without prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,
ORDERED, That Manchester's request to dismiss the complaint, without prejudice, be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 08-360-GA-CSS be dismissed without prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
