ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By entry of April 28, 2000, the hearing in this case was continued to May 30, 2000, the deadline for filing CG&E's supplemental testimony related to the operational support plan and intervenor testimony was changed to May 16, 2000, and the deadline for filing staff testimony was extended to May 25, 2000.
- (2) On May 1, 2000, the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) filed a motion to intervene. Upon review of the motion, the examiner finds that sufficient interest has been stated to warrant intervention and ODOD's motion for intervention should be granted.
- (3) On May 11, 2000, a prehearing conference was held in this case at which a number of procedural matters were discussed. As a result of the discussion the examiner finds as follows: Testimony by any party in support of the stipulation and CG&E's supplemental testimony related to the operational support plan should be filed on or before May 17, 2000; Testimony by intervenor parties either in opposition to the stipulation or otherwise, should be filed on or before May 24, 2000; All parties should make witnesses available for discovery between May 12 and May 29, 2000. Finally, any party that seeks to cross-examine witnesses should identify those witnesses and notify all parties by May 16, 2000. Any changes to their witness lists should be made no later than May 24, 2000.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the procedural dates for filing testimony and the identification of witnesses be revised as set forth in Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That the ODOD's motion to intervene be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
