## FINDINGS

This corrective action was verified by Mr. Gary Elkins of the UTU on September $28^{\text {th }}$; as Mr. Elkins represented the complainant no on site inspection was conducted.

## CONCLUSIONS \& RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on these findings, I recommend that the Complaint should be closed.
