## **FINDINGS**

On September 22<sup>nd</sup>, I met with acting Terminal Superintendent, Mr. Mark Wagner to discuss this and four other complaints. Mr. Wagner said that he believed that the problem had already been corrected but he would contact Caraustar Industries to verify that.

On September 23<sup>rd</sup> Mr. Wagner forwarded an email from Mr. Eric Michener of Carraustar industries stating that the weeds and vegetation had been taken care of approximately 2 weeks prior. This corrective action was verified by Mr. Gary Elkins of the UTU on September 28<sup>th</sup>; as Mr. Elkins represented the complainant no on site inspection was conducted.

## **CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS**

Based on these findings, I recommend that the Complaint should be closed.
