MS. BROUGHTON: Deborah Broughton, 162 Township Road 616, South Point, Ohio 45680, office manager, and Kenneth E. Cogan, owner/operator.

HEARING EXAMINER SHEETS: Okay.

HEARING EXAMINER SHEETS: Thank you. Do you have a statement to make, Mr. Margard?

MR. MARGARD: I do. And thank you, Your Honor. The parties have reached a settlement of this case and we would like to indicate the basic terms of that settlement on the record and then follow it up with a joint exhibit memorializing that agreement.

HEARING EXAMINER SHEETS: Very good.

MR. MARGARD: The parties have agreed that the Respondent will accept the compliance review and the violations stated therein. The Staff will reduce the amount of forfeiture by half. The forfeiture was total of \$10,950, so half of that would be \$5,475. The Staff is willing to accept monthly payments over the course of the next year, following the issuance of an order accepting the settlement for payment of that sum and will waive the remainder of the assessed forfeiture. That waiver is occasioned by the fact that the Respondent has subsequently had a compliance review that has found none of the violations that were found in this instance.

So Staff believes that the good faith efforts on the part of the Respondent justify the reduction of the forfeiture in this case.
