Thank you for your concerns regarding the proposed American Transmission Systems, Inc. / Geauga County -138kV Transmission Line Supply Project. As with the consideration of all transmission projects, local and surrounding businesses, residents, municipalities and officials are invited to discuss the present and long-term economical and environmental feasibility of such projects.

In reviewing all particulars of the American Transmission Systems, Inc. / Geauga County -138kV Transmission Line Supply Project, both public and adjudicatory hearings, our Staff Report of Investigation, intervenors interrogatories, and the concerns of those residents living within the Geauga County area, the OPSB found that American Transmission Systems, Inc application satisfied all of the criteria established in accordance with Chapter 4906, of the Ohio Administrative Code.

Therefore, on November 24, 2008 the Board issued an Opinion, Order and Certificate to American Transmission Systems, Inc. for the siting, construction, operation, maintenance, 138kV Transmission Line Supply Project, as modified pursuant to the opinion, order, and certificate.

We are sending this letter to request revisions to the proposed transmission line route through our properties located along Ledge Road and our property located south of Rock Creek Road in Thompson Township, Geauga County, Ohio. From what we understand the original proposed route was finally approved this year and the line will be going through portions of our properties. However, we were never in favor of the original route of this line and have discussed various possibilities with representatives of First Energy (American Transmission Systems, Incorporated) over the past 2 – 3 years.

As neighbors, we have determined a new mutually beneficial route that would move the line away from the front yards of the Lausin family homes and also away from the R.W. Sidley, Inc. operations along the west side of Ledge Road. It is our collective desire to reroute this pole line in an easterly direction along the southern edge of the R.W. Sidley, Inc. Tax Parcel No. 30-069800 and continue through that property in a northeasterly direction parallel to the old abandoned Phillips Road. This line would then enter the Lausin Ledge Co., LTD. property and continue through the farm along their back tree line. The new route would reduce the number of poles, guy wires and road crossing wires along Ledge Road. We feel this new route makes the most sense and we request the necessary steps be taken to formally submit this change in the route.

For your information, last year we began assessing our property in this area and found that the above mentioned parcel contained a considerable amount of quality grade timber. We began harvesting he trees on this property along with another neighbor and during the process the idea of relocating the line through this property started to make a lot of sense.

We are also requesting a change to the route across the R.W. Sidley, Inc. Tax Parcel No. 30-069200. The proposed route will be less intrusive to the future wetlands expansion south of Rock Creek Road. We request the necessary steps be taken to formally submit this change in the route as well.


