ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On November 14, 2008, the Commission approved the issuance of a renewed Certificate No. 00-003(5), to Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. (Constellation or applicant) to provide competitive retail power marketer and power broker services in the state of Ohio. The expiration date for Certificate No. 00-003(5) is November 11, 2010.
- (2) On October 8, 2010, Constellation filed a motion for an extension of the expiration date of its existing certificate and a request for an expedited ruling pursuant to Rule 4901-1-12(C) and (F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). In its motion, Constellation states that, "due to the press of internal business, it failed to file its renewal application within the requisite time frame. The applicant represents that it will file its application for the renewal of its certification for competitive retail electric service no later than October 26, 2010.
- (3) The attorney examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 00-003(5) to November 25, 2010, is warranted so that Constellation's customers will not be adversely affected while its renewal application is under consideration.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Constellation's motion for an extension of the certificate expiration date is granted in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further

ORDERED, That the November 11, 2010, expiration date of Certificate No. 00-003(5) be extended to November 25, 2010. It is, further,
