This will serve as a Status Report in the above matter.


Per recent communications, Miamisburg advises that it is finalizing the technical/engineering portion (as to logistics and cost, etc.) of its proposal to close two separate crossings within the Miamisburg corridor. Miamisburg then intends to share and discuss this information with Norfolk Southern, and should then be in a position to follow with its city council,

toward securing authority to enter into an appropriate letter agreement addressing the entire Miamisburg corridor.

Assuming the Commission's approval, Norfolk Southern will file a further Status Report by December 20, 2010.
