## **Project Overview:**

The Self Direct Prescriptive project that Guardian Auto Products has completed and applied is as follows: retrofit of 288, 400W Metal Halide lighting fixtures with 288 6Lamp T5 fixtures and installation of occupancy sensors on these newly installed T5 fixtures. This facility is expanded by adding a new construction of 80,000 sq ft to it. The newly constructed part of this facility is also equipped with another 132 new 6Lamp T5 fixtures which are controlled by motion sensors. Wattage reduction and occupancy sensor measures are applied for the existing part of the facility; Lighting density and occupancy sensor measures are applied for the new construction section of this facility.
