I am writing regarding the all-electric discount, which was withdrawn last year. As one of the newly underemployed, I frequently went without enough heat last winter as a direct result of the rate increase. My bills tripled, and I simply did not have enough income to cover the balance. My days were spent shoveling, looking for work, or indoors, wrapped in blankets, drinking tea in an attempt to stay warm. When I bought my home in 1997, I had to fight to get the all-electric discount, and was never back-credited for the year and a half I had paid full price on electricity as a renter. It took numerous efforts to force the FE/Illuminating Co. to give me the all-electric rate. The thought of doing without this necessity for another winter alarms me greatly. While the economy has improved elsewhere, Ohio still lags behind in unemployment decreases. I remain affected by this lag, and require the discount in order to provide even moderate warmth to my home. Please consider the needs of the people who were promised this discount when making your decision to reinstate it permanently. There are countless citizens potentially dreading another winter with a bare minimum of affordable heat. I am certainly one of them. Thank you in advance for your kind consideration.
