The Self Direct (Prescriptive and Custom) project that the above has completed and applied is as follows.

- (7255) 4' lamps retrofitted with new electronic ballasts to operate reduced wattage T8 lamps instead of T12 lamps
- (656) 4' T12 lamps removed as part of retrofitting fixtures from T12 to T8
- (38) 4' U-Tube lamps retrofitted with new electronic ballasts to operate reduced wattage T8 lamps instead of T12 lamps
- (12) 4' 3L T12 fixtures retrofitted to be 4' 4L T8, which is treated as a custom measure using standard hours of operation
- (3) Screw in fixtures replaced with 2-Lamp screw in CFL fixtures
- (47) Incandescent lamps replaced with screw-in CFL lamps in the range of 5-15W
- (34) Incandescent lamps replaced with screw-in CFL lamps in the range of 16-26W
- (14) Incandescent lamps replaced with screw-in 40W CFL lamps
- (41) Incandescent exit signs replaced with LED exit signs
- (71) 4' 2 lamp T12 fixtures replaced with new 4' 2 lamp T8 fixtures
- (2) Incandescent fixtures replaced with 4' 2L T8 fixtures
- (75) 400W MH lamps replaced by 6 Lamp T8 fixtures
