While we are very concerned with the safety both of our employees and other motorists, we feel that the regulations are overly burdensome, especially all of the paperwork that will be required. Most small businesses are already struggling in this economy, and these bureaucratic requirements will create additional burdens and are not likely to improve safety.

Additionally, most businesses in our industry have either just been made aware of, or are still unaware, of these changes. It will be incredibly difficult for us to ensure that we are in compliance by January 1, 2011.
