How would you like to save money and improve your comfort?

Enclosed is an analysis of your electric bills for the last 12 months. This analysis compares your actual electric bills to those same bills calculated on our new demandless seasonal rate 11B. According to the analysis, the rate 11B demandless option could save you approximately \$ 25.00 a year.

To take advantage of this rate, an 80 gallon electric water heater and Ohio Edison's Power Commander Equipment must be installed. If you do not have an 80 gallon tank at present, Ohio Edison offers 0% APR financing, with approved credit, (up to \$600.00) with monthly payments in increments of \$10.00 added right to your electric bill up to 36 months. This special financing is offered through all of the Tank Commanders on the list provided.

Should you not wish to finance the water heater simply have the 80 gallon electric water tank installed, then contact a Power Commander Installer to receive your equipment. Installers charge between \$100-\$125 to position the equipment. Ohio Edison then rebates \$75.00 back to you or the installer.

To change your electric rate Ohio Edison must verify the water heater and Power Commander installation, and receive your signature on the enclosed rate agreement form. Because this new rate is demandless, Ohio Edison would then remove your demand meter and install a general purpose meter which only records your kWh usage.

Please, contact a Tank Commander today so you, too, can start to save.

CONDITIONS OF RATE OPTIONS

I agree to have installed the necessary wiring and devices as required for this "controlled" rates and to make them accessible as may be required. The Company will bill me on the rate beginning with the next applicable billing cycle after verification of this installation.

Controlled Water Heating Rates - Rates 10B, 11B, 14A, 14D, and 14E require a minimum of 50 gallons of water heater tank capacity.

Rate 11A, 11B - This rate is only available where electricity is the primary source of heat and where at least ninety-five percent of the electrical consumption is within the residence.

Rates 14A, B, C, D, E are not available to customers with whole house load controls.

Rates 14C, 14E require a minimum of 12.5 kW of resistance heating capacity.

Rate 15 requires a minimum of 50 gallons of water heater tank capacity.
