ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 18, 2010, Stephen Douglas filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (2) The parties participated in a prehearing conference on October 12, 2010, but were unable to resolve matters at that time. By entry issued on October 13, 2010, a hearing date of December 14, 2010, was scheduled.
- (3) In late November 2010 Mr. Douglas informed the attorney examiner by telephone that he would pay the civil forfeiture instead of going to hearing.
- (4) On December 8, 2010, Commission staff filed a letter noting that Mr. Douglas had paid the civil forfeiture. Staff also requested that the case be dismissed.
- (5) Rule 4901:2-7-22, Ohio Administrative Code, provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (6) In view of the payment of the forfeiture, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the this case be dismissed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


