ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On November 2, 2010, Auglaize Hydroelectric Plant Unit 3 filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code, this application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. The rule also provides that the Commission may suspend an application during the 60-day approval process.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional information and investigation is necessary to thoroughly review this application. Therefore, good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process for Auglaize Hydroelectric Plant Unit 3's application for certification, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for the application of Auglaize Hydroelectric Plant Unit 3 for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in this case.
