MOTION FOR ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Pursuant to Rule 4901-1-25, Ohio Administrative Code, and other applicable authority,
Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and The Toledo Edison
Company (collectively "Companies") move for the issuance of a subpoena in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

There is good cause for issuance of this subpoena, which commands Tom Logan to produce the original version of a letter dated June 18, 1988 ("Letter") that purportedly was sent by Elio Andreatta. Mr. Logan appeared as a witness at the October 27, 2010 public hearing in Strongsville, Ohio. At that hearing, Mr. Logan testified to having received the Letter, which he contends constituted an agreement for a fixed all-electric rate. (See Tr. Vol I of Oct. 27, 2010 public hearing, pp. 124-27 (attached as Ex. B).) The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC") offered this letter into evidence at that hearing, where it was marked as Strongsville Exhibit 2. (See Ex. C.) The Companies believe that there are questions as to the authenticity (and ultimate admissibility) of the Letter and therefore request the issuance of this subpoena in order to examine the original version of the Letter.

I wish to submit herewith a written document issued by an authorized Ohio Edison employee that shows that Ohio Edison did enter into a permanent, fixed rate agreement with me as an all-electric homeowner. The document I am submitting states that. "Even if Ohio Edison ever removes this rate from our files, you will not be in jeopardy

I have asked myself, why has FirstEnergy lost its moral compass and engaged a busload of Philadelphia lawyers to extricate itself from an Я agreement they do not now like. The answer is simple.
