MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The OCC requests a subpoena, pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-25, to command Mr. Elio Andreatta to appear and provide oral testimony on February 7, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. and attend the hearing from day to day until called to testify by the OCC at the Commission offices (180 E. Broad Street, 11th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215) in the above-captioned proceeding. A previous subpoena was issued for Mr. Andreatta's appearance at the hearing that was scheduled to begin on January 27, 2011, but that hearing was continued by Entry dated January 26, 2011. A new subpoena should be issued that correctly identifies the new date (i.e. February 7, 2011) for the beginning of the hearing and for the Mr. Andreaatta's appearance to testify at that hearing.

The above-captioned case involves charges by the Ohio Edison Company, the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and the Toledo Edison Company to customers for electric service, and especially the charges paid by customers whose service was or could have been provided according to the terms of non-standard residential tariffs. As part of the Commission's inquiries, the PUCO scheduled and conducted six local public hearings, stating in its Entry that the Commission was "particularly interested in receiving more information . . . about the following: <u>Commitments:</u> If you are in an all-electric home, what contacts or written documents do you have regarding your electric rates now and in the future? Was there a commitment that the rate would remain with the home for future owners?"² Mr. Andreatta's is expected to be able to provide insights on this topic if called to testify.

Local public hearings followed the Commission's Entry that discussed utility commitments, including a hearing in Strongsville, Ohio on October 27, 2010. Mr. Thomas Logan appeared and testified under oath at the Strongsville hearing, making statements and also offering a letter (with accompanying attachments, the "Letter") on Ohio Edison's letterhead dated June 18, 1988.³ The Letter makes a representation regarding the continuation of service according to a non-standard tariff "as long as you wish to utilize it."⁴ Mr. Elio Andreatta is shown on the Letter as its author.⁵ OCC counsel asked that the Letter presented by Mr. Logan be marked as Strongsville Ex. 2 and moved for its admission into evidence. The contents of the Letter provides one type of information that the Commission seeks in this case, and Mr. Andreatta's insights concerning sales activities at Ohio Edison (including, but not limited to the contents of the Letter) are important to this case.

The exhibit shows Mr. Andreatta as the author of that letter dated June 18, 1988. The witness shall submit oral testimony regarding the letter and his activities while employed by any and all of the FirstEnergy electric distribution utilities.
