Requirements, American Electric Power submits the following.

4906-11-02 (B)

(1) Name of Project

The name of this project is the Lima – Fort Wayne 138kV Line, Install 2 Tap Structures for Timber Road II Station.

(2) Description of Project

Two self supporting steel structures will be installed within AEP's existing right of way to bring the Haviland – Milan circuit into the new Timber Road II Station. See Map A. This project meets the requirements of a Construction Notice as outlined in Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4906-1-01 Appendix A, Item 1, Part (d) "line(s) one hundred twenty-five kV and above, but less than three hundred kV, and not greater than 0.2 miles in length".

(3) Need of Project

AEP is installing 2 steel tap structures on the Lima – Fort Wayne 138kV line in order to facilitate Horizon Wind Energy's new Timber Road II Wind Farm connection to the electric transmission system. Paulding Wind Farm II, LLC filed an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board, Case 10-0369-EL-BGN, and received approval November 18, 2010.

(4) Construction Schedule

Construction of this transmission line project is expected to begin mid March 2011 and be completed by late April 2011.

(5) Estimated Cost

The cost of this project is estimated to be \$401,000.

(6) Right of Way Requirements

No additional right-of-way easements or right-of-way clearing will be required for this project.

(7) Map

The line is located in Paulding County, approximately 140 miles Northwest of Columbus, OH. From Columbus, OH take US 33 W toward Marysville to US-127-N near Mendon, OH. Follow US-127 to US-30 W to OH-49 N then left onto OH-114 W. The project's address is 3434 SR-114 Payne, OH 45880.

(7) Properties

The construction of this project is within the Lima – Fort Wayne 138kV easement width and property owned by Paulding Wind Farm II, LLC, a subsidiary of Horizon Wind Energy.




