EXHIBIT C

The Applicant, The Fort Jennings Telephone Company, hereby seeks approval primarily to integrate its touch-tone rates into its basic access line rates. By doing so, the Applicant will eliminate a line item charge on most customers' bills, which results in a simpler bill. Currently, 36 of the Applicant's 850 customers remain on rotary dial service. Those customers will be grandfathered and will receive a credit each month of the touch-tone rate that will now be included in all customers' basic access line rates. However, upon any change to service, those customers must upgrade to touch-tone service. The Applicant will inform grandfathered customers at the time they make such a change to their service that the change will result in an upgrade to touch-tone service and of the associated charge that will be added to their bill.

In addition, the Applicant is hereby deleting its Extended Local Calling Plan and Optional Toll Calling Plan A, both of which established certain rates for customers in the Fort Jennings Exchange who place calls to the Delphos Exchange. Upon the approval of this Application, calls placed by those customers to the Delphos Exchange will be considered local calls, with no additional charge.

(Customer Notice)

The following notice will appear on bills that mail to customers on February 28, 2011:

"Effective with the April bill, the charge for touch tone service will be included in your monthly basic access line rate. Customers who do not have touch-tone service will be "grandfathered" and will receive a credit of \$1.00 for the touch-tone amount. However, any change made by a customer who does not currently have touch-tone service will result in an upgrade to touch-tone and the loss of the touch-tone credit."


"Additionally, as of March 17, 2011, all calls made by customers in the Fort Jennings Exchange to the Delphos Exchange will be toll-free. Customers will no longer pay per-minute charges or a monthly fee for calls placed from the Fort Jennings Exchange to the Delphos Exchange."
