On February 18, 2011, Miamisburg confirmed that a recent meeting had been canceled, due to inclement weather, and its council was now scheduled to meet on March 1 (in study session) to review the instant consolidation project, in anticipation of moving forward with first and second readings of related consent legislation, on March 15 and April 5, respectively.

The parties hope to reach an agreement by that date (meaning by April 5, 2011), which would then be confirmed via formal subsidy agreement to be executed by all interested parties.

Assuming the Commission's approval, Norfolk Southern will file a further Status Report by April 8, 2011.
