ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 2, 2010, Herbert Bott (complainant) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison) in which he alleged that Ohio Edison improperly charged him for service used by his tenant.
- (2) Ohio Edison filed an answer to the complaint on July 22, 2010. In its answer, Ohio Edison alleged that it did not charge the complainant for services used by a tenant. Instead, Ohio Edison asserted that it transferred several unpaid, residential account balances under the complainant's name to the complainant's newly opened account.
- (3) By entry issued October 4, 2010, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a settlement conference to occur on November 4, 2010.
- (4) On February 3, 2011, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. The parties explain that they have settled the dispute.
- (5) Being advised that the parties have resolved the issues and wish to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, the joint motion to dismiss should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with Finding (5), the complaint in this matter be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
