The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 29, 2010, Avon Lake Solar 1, LLC (Avon Lake) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code, provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility unless the Commission suspends the application within sixty days. Avon Lake's application was suspended on March 2, 2010.
- (3) On December 14, 2010, Avon Lake filed a request to withdraw its application on the basis that the facility was being registered by SolSystems, a solar energy resource aggregator, under a different case number.
- (4) The Commission finds that Avon Lake's request to withdraw its application is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Avon Lake's request to withdraw its application be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 10-0098-EL-REN be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
