I did consider some of the information you gave me about calling to have electric restored in February 2008 and made an additional adjustment. Your account was credited $\$ 593.10$ for the period of December 27, 2007 through February 26, 2008.

## Complaint:

In July 2007 I moved into the apartment at the address above. I contacted Duke Energy to have the utilities turned on in my name. After providing all of the appropriate information I began receiving the utility bills which I paid each month. Approximately, October 2007 I retumed home from vacation and discovered that my electricity had been disconnected. I believe it had been off for several days as all of the food in the refrigerator was spoiled. I contacted Duke Energy the day I returned to find out why the electricity had been turned off to which they responded that the electricity should not have been disconnected, because they were not my energy provider. I asked the customer service rep. if they were not, then who was? However, she sent someone out that same night to reconnect my electricity.

I checked with DJ of Mutual Realtors, manager of the apartment, and discovered that Duke Energy was the providers of electric and gas to the apartment. I contacted Duke and explained that they sent bills of gas only. I continued to pay my utility bills monthly and then in February 2008 I returned home from work to discover that again my power had been disconnected. I contacted Duke Energy once again and once again they sent someone out to reconneet the power. The Duke Energy customer service rep. stated that she saw no reason why I should have been disconnected.

I continued to pay my utility bills monthly and then again, approximately seven months later in September 2008, I returned home from work to discover my power had again been disconnected. I contacted Duke Energy again and again they reconnected my power. I told them that it must be a problem with their meters or something. Each time I contacted them they reconnected my power however they never gave any indication as to why my power continued to be disconnected.

Then in April 2009 I received a bill in the amount of $\$ 2140.41$ for the period Feb 26 to Mar 27. I was shocked to see a bill that large as I had been paying my bills on a monthly basis as required. The bill showed an amount due from the previous bill and balance forward of $\$ 2586.02$, current gas and electric charges of $\$ 147.49$ and a credit adjustment of $\$ 593.10$. I had no idea where the amount due came from because the bill I received prior to that was for $\$ 25.09$ for period Jan 28 to Feb 26. Inever received a bill that provided any detail about the $\sim \$ 2500$ charges. I did receive the May billing statement which indicated on the graph chart that I used $46,330 \mathrm{kWh}$ in the March 2009 and 647 kWh in April of 2009 for a total of $46,977 \mathrm{kWh}$. I contacted Duke Energy an explanation and requested detail for that bill because there was no way that could have used that much energy, but they only provided copies of the same bills of March 2009-April 2009, I had received for $\$ 25.09$ and $\$ 2140.41$--no detail. Then I contacted Duke Energy again and spoke to Phillip Malone who provided a printout of some electric usage. I was told these charges dated back two years.

With the response and resolution I got from Duke Energy, which was basically a printout of electric usage and being told I owed the bill in full with no reason as to how this happened. I then contacted the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio and filed an informal complaint. I talked to Stephen Watson who intervened on my behalf and talked to Alicia at Duke Energy. After speaking to Alicia, Stephen told me that Duke Energy could only bill me for electric usage retroactive 18 months. As a result my account was credited an additional $\$ 363$ on the Jun 2009 bill for the period Dec 27, , 07 to Feb 26, ${ }^{\prime} 08$. I then talked to Alicia who told me I could pay in installments of $\$ 200 /$ month for the next nine months in addition to my regular monthly usage.

Through all of this, in my conversations with Phillip and Alicia 1 discovered through Karen Brunsman, the manager of the building for RBDB Investment, that the bulding was wired incorrectly. Once the building was correctly rewired Duke Energy billed me for electric usage for the past two years and therefore they sent me this bill for over $\$ 2000$. I have forward you a copy of an email that Dan Buchanan, co-owner of the property at 6087 Montgomery Rd. sent his attorney stating the fact that the building was r\& wired netting in the bill coming to me. I do not believe that the bill for $\$ 2140.41$ is my responsibility, I believe that it should fall on Duke energy and the owner of the property who did not do their part in making sure the everything was in proper working order prior to passing the building inspection and renting out to the resident.

It is my understanding that the building was re-wired, approximately a year ago. and now Duke has sent Jerry a $\$ 2000.00$ bill, and my understanding is that the bill is due to the rewiring?

Jerry has told me he has paid all of his bills, and I told him that his cashed checks will be helpful in this.

I am willing to pay for the initial meeting between you and Jerry, so you can asses this, as he has been a good employee and being RBDB used to own the building, I would like to see this work out for him.

As you know, I continue to collect rent check from all of the tenants, to pay the mortgage and other operating expenses of the building, while the building goes thru the bankruptcy process. Karen Brunsman still manages the building, and was somewhat familiar with the Duke issues, and re-wiring, from a year or so ago.

Let me know if you will meet with Jerry on this.
