ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 30, 2010, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a March 3, 2011, hearing in this matter.
- (2) On March 2, 2011, counsel for Toledo Edison filed a joint motion for continuance of the hearing until March 18, 2011. The joint motion explains that time conflicts have arisen for Toledo Edison regarding the March 3, 2011, hearing date.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds the motion for continuance to be reasonable. Therefore, the motion shall be granted, and the hearing shall be continued to March 18, 2011, at 1:30 P.M. in Hearing Room 11-D, 11<sup>th</sup> floor of the Commission offices, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (4) Any party intending to present direct, expert testimony should comply with Rule 4901-1-29(A)(1)(h), Ohio Administrative Code, which requires that all such testimony to be offered in this type of proceeding be filed and served upon all parties no later than seven days prior to the commencement of the hearing.
- (5) As is the case in all Commission complaint proceedings, the Complainant has the burden of proving the allegations of the complaint. *Grossman v. Public Util. Comm.* (1966), 5 Ohio St.2d 198.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


