Description of Filing

This filing increases the rates for residential BLES by \$1.25 in all Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company (CBT) exchanges. These price increases are in accordance with the price flexibility granted to CBT under BLES alternative regulation and Ohio Revised Code Section 4927.12 (C)(3). CBT is also increasing the price for additional residential lines outside of bundles by \$1.25. Thus, CBT will continue to price BLES lines and additional lines the same for residential customers who purchase these services outside of bundles. Customers with discounts on their BLES lines and/or additional lines, e.g. promotional discounts or vacation line service, will continue to receive their discounts until the discount period expires.

Additionally, CBT is increasing the price of directory assistance services for all customers. For residential customers, prices will increase from \$1.75 to \$1.99. For nonresidence customers, including public telephone service, prices will increase from \$1.75 to \$2.50. These price increases apply to all types of directory assistance, including local directory assistance, national directory assistance, reverse search and business category search.

All of the price changes are effective beginning March 17, 2011. However, CBT will not bill fractional charges for the monthly access line price changes for the period from March 17 until the customer's next bill date. In other words, the effective date of the monthly service price changes for each customer will be the customer's first bill date on or after March 17. CBT provided customer notice of these price changes as noted in Exhibit D.
