Complainant, Sherry A. Wiley's Motion to Issue Subpoenas

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Section 4901-1-25, the Complainant,
Sherry A. Wiley, respectfully asks the Commission to issue a subpoena to Duke Energy
Corporation, Dianne B. Kuhnell, 139 East Fourth Street, P.O. Box 960, Cincinnati, Ohio
45201; and the Ohio Department of Development, HEAP, Lee Frich, Room 1,
Columbus, Ohio 43215, to both companies for their production of documents, in its
entirety; including, but not limited too; all telephone recorded calls - with emphases on recorded calls with "Tony" & "Lonnie", Customer Service Representatives on October
19, 2010, as well as all other recorded calls, memo's and notes, etc., - with emphases
on - all documentation, including, but not limited too; statements when HEAP

payment was received by Duke Energy as well as when Duke Energy applied benefit and date and information sent back to the HEAP Department confirming benefit being applied to complainant's account and all other information, all documentation, all recordings, all memo's, all notes; everything regarding Complainant. The reason in support of this Motion are set forth in the following Memorandum in Support.

Memorandum in Support

Section 4901-1-25 Subpoenas and Section 4901-2 Confidential and Personal information of the Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") states, in part, the following:

Section 4901-1-25 Subpoenas of the Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") in its entirety with emphases the following:

(G) If any person fails to obey a subpoena Issued by the commission, a commissioner, the legal director, the deputy legal director, or an attorney examiner, the commission may seek appropriate judicial relief against such person under section 4903.02 or 4903.04 of the Revised Code.

Section 4901-2 Confidential and Personal information of the Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") in its entirety:

For the purposes of administrative rules promulgated in accordance with section 1347.15 of the Revised Code, the following definitions apply:

(A) "Access" as a noun means an instance of copying, viewing, or otherwise perceiving whereas "access" as a verb means to copy, view, or otherwise perceive.

- (B) "Acquisition of a new computer system" means the purchase of a "computer system," as defined in this rule, that is not a computer system currently in place nor one for which the acquisition process has been initiated as of the effective date of the agency rule addressing requirements in section <u>1347.15</u> of the Revised Code.
- (C) "Computer system" means a "system," as defined by section <u>1347.01</u> of the Revised Code, that stores, maintains, or retrieves personal information using electronic data processing equipment.
- (D) "Confidential personal Information" (CPI) has the meaning as defined by division (A)(1) of section 1347.15 of the Revised Code and identified by rules promulgated by the agency in accordance with division (B)(3) of section 1347.15 of the Revised Code that reference the federal or state statutes or administrative rules that make personal information maintained by the agency confidential.
- (E) "Employee of the state agency" means each employee of a state agency regardless of whether he/she holds an elected or appointed office or position within the state agency. "Employee of the state agency" is limited to the specific employing state agency.
- (F) "Incidental contact" means contact with the information that is secondary or tangential to the primary purpose of the activity that resulted in the contact.
- (G) "Individual" means a natural person or the natural person's authorized representative, legal counsel, legal custodian, or legal guardian.
- (H) "Information owner" means the individual appointed in accordance with division (A) of section 1347.05 of the Revised Code to be directly responsible for a system.
- (I) "Person" means a natural person.

(J) "Personal Information" has the same meaning as defined in division (E) of section

1347.01 of the Revised Code.

(K) "Personal information system" means a "system" that "maintains" "personal

information" as those terms are defined in section 1347.01 of the Revised Code.

"System" includes manual and computer systems.

(L) "Research" means a methodical investigation into a subject.

(M) "Routine" means commonplace, regular, habitual, or ordinary.

(N) "Routine information that is maintained for the purpose of internal office

administration, the use of which would not adversely affect a person" as that phrase is

used in division (F) of section 1347.01 of the Revised Code means personal information

relating to employees and maintained by the agency for internal administrative and

human resource purposes.

(O) "System" has the same meaning as defined by division (F) of section 1347.01 of the

Revised Code.

(P) "Upgrade" means a substantial redesign of an existing computer system for the

purpose of providing a substantial amount of new application functionality, or application

modifications that would involve substantial administrative or fiscal resources to

implement, but would not include maintenance, minor updates and patches, or

modifications that entail a limited addition of functionality due to changes in business or

legal requirements.
