Duke Energy Ohio would, for the record, like to correct two typographical errors that appeared in its Application for Rehearing, filed on March 25, 2011:

- 1. On Page 11: The rules for a CBP must be the same regardless of the structure of the SSO. To do otherwise effectively permits the Commission to approve a CBP that either affords customers a lesser degree of protection under an ESP or makes the CBP standard for an MRO so erroneous onerous that it is not a viable option for EDUs.
- 2. On Pages 19-20: Clearly, there is no requirement that costs must be extraordinary ordinary in order to be recoverable and it is thus error for the Commission to disregard the plain reading of the statute and force such a requirement upon Duke Energy Ohio.
