The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On March 15, 2011, Mr. Joseph R. Stewart, an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Ohio, filed a motion pursuant to Rule XII, Section 2(A)(6) of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio (Gov. Bar Rules). He seeks the admission pro hac vice of Ms. Zsuzsanna E. Benedek to represent CenturyTel of Ohio dba CenturyLink (CenturyTel) in this proceeding.
- (2) The motion states that Ms. Benedek is licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The motion further states that, in compliance with Gov. Bar Rule XII(2)(A)(5), Ms. Benedek has not been granted permission to appear pro hac vice in more than three proceedings before Ohio tribunals in the current calendar year. To complete her motion, Ms. Benedek attached a copy of an affidavit and certificate of pro hac vice registration in compliance with Gov. Bar Rule XII(2)(A)(3).
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that the motion pro hac vice fulfills the requirements of Gov. Bar Rule XII(2). Consequently, the motion should be granted. Ms. Benedek shall be permitted to appear and participate as counsel or co-counsel in this matter on behalf of CenturyTel.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with Finding (3), the motion for the admission pro hac vice of Ms. Benedek is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties, counsel, and interested persons of record.


