The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 16, 2010, Christopher Lemke and Toby J. Eichman filed identical complaints against The Toledo Edison Company (TE), stating that complainants both have had difficulty reaching interconnection agreements with TE for wind generators installed at complainants' properties.
- (2) On March 3, 2010, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) moved to intervene in these proceedings.
- (3) On March 8, 2010, TE filed its answer to these complaints.
- (4) By entry issued March 4, 2011, the case was scheduled for a hearing to commence on May 17, 2011.

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(5) On May 9, 2011, OCC filed a motion requesting a continuance of the procedural schedule. Specifically, OCC explained that the parties are currently involved in settlement discussions and need more time to discuss a potential resolution of these matters. OCC further states that it has contacted the other parties to this case and none of the other parties object to the continuance. The attorney examiner finds that OCC's request is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, all testimony should be prefiled by May 24, 2011, and the hearing will commence on May 31, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That OCC's motion for a continuance be granted, and the procedural schedule set forth in Finding (5) be observed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
