ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- On January 19, 2011, the Commission opened dockets for the (1) purpose of receiving filings related to the requirement of Section 4905.302, Revised Code, that the Commission conduct, or cause to be conducted, periodic audits of each gas or natural gas company under the Commission's jurisdiction to review each company's compliance with the gas cost recovery (GCR) mechanism delineated in Chapter 4901:1-14, Administrative Code (O.A.C.). Further, dockets were opened for the purpose of receiving filings related to the Commission's initiated audits of uncollectible expense (UEX) riders. In Case Nos. 11-210-GA-GCR and 11-310-GA-UEX, Glenwood Energy of Oxford, Inc. (Glenwood) was a designated public utility subject to such respective audits.
- (2) By entry issued January 19, 2011, the Commission ordered that a public hearing be held for Glenwood on July 19, 2011. Additionally, the Commission ordered Staff to file its GCR audit report at least 60 days prior to the public hearing date.
- (3) On May 13, 2011, Staff filed a motion requesting an extension of the deadline for the filing of Staff's GCR audit report and a continuance of the hearing. In support of its motion, Staff states that it has encountered an unexpected work load in other GCR cases and, consequently, requires additional time to complete its report. Staff requests that the deadline for submission of the audit report in both cases be extended to July 1, 2011, and that the hearing be continued until September 1, 2011. Additionally, Staff states that Glenwood

- does not object to its requests and that Glenwood has not yet published notice for the GCR hearing.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that Staff's motion is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the deadline for submitting the audit report in both cases shall be extended to July 1, 2011. Additionally, the hearing in this matter shall be rescheduled to Thursday, September 1, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (5) Rule 4901:1-14-08(C), O.A.C., specifies the requirement for notice of a GCR hearing, which each company should cause to be published between 15 and 30 days prior to the date set for its hearing. The notice may be provided by publication of a display ad in a newspaper (in a section other than the legal notice section), bill message, bill insert, or direct mailing to the customers. The form of the notice should be in substantially the following form as applicable to the individual company.

LEGAL NOTICE

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has set for public hearing Case No. 11-210-GA-GCR to review the gas cost recovery rates of Glenwood Energy of Oxford, Inc. and the operation of its purchased gas adjustment clause, and related matters. This hearing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 1, 2011, at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793. All interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard. (6) The direct testimony of any witnesses testifying on behalf of each company should be filed at least 16 days prior to the GCR hearing. All direct testimony to be presented by any other party should be filed at least seven days prior to the hearing.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Staff's motion for an extension of the procedural schedule be granted in accordance with finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That Glenwood publish legal notice in accordance with finding (5). It is, further,

ORDERED, That the direct testimony be filed in the GCR cases consistent with finding (6). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
