This will serve as a Status Report in the above matter.


On April 26, 2011 Miamisburg's city council passed consent legislation providing for the closure of the vehicular crossing at Buckeye Street and the pedestrian crossing at Park Avenue.

The ORDC is now preparing and will circulate a confirmatory subsidy agreement to be executed by all parties in interest, and which will confirm the improvements to be made throughout the Miamisburg corridor, including at the Kercher Street crossing.

Assuming the Commission's approval, Norfolk Southern will file a further Status Report by July 6, 2011.
