On May 13, 2011, CenturyLink Operating Companies' filed Transmittal No. 4 with the Federal Communications Commission. This filing will become effective May 28, 2011. In this filing, CenturyLink Operating Companies Tariff F.C.C. No. 9 proposed the following revisions:

- 1) Addition of nonrecurring special construction charges in the states of Minnesota, Missouri and Texas;

- 1) Addition of four new companies to the issuing carriers list for special construction in Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.
- 2) Addition of Section 20, Mebtel, Inc. rate references within the various sections of Tariff F.C.C. No. 7.
- 3) Removal of rates for ATM-CRS service for Mebtel, Inc. in Tariff F.C.C. No. 7. There is no supporting service description defined in the tariff and CenturyLink has no current customer demand paying any of these charges.
