AEP Ohio has established a strong record of leadership as acresponsible corporate partner to the Shawnee State University Development Foundation: Please accept this letter as evidence of AEP Ohio's substantial philanthropic support and commitment to invest in higher education and economic development. AEP Ohio recognizes through its commitment to our initiatives that, in addition to being an institution of higher education, Shawnee State University also serves as a vital player in the regional and state economy.

Over the past five years, AEP Ohio and the AEP Foundation contributed in excess of \$25,000 to Development Foundation scholarships and \$150,000 in support of a seven-part plan to lead SSU to a new level of excellence. This year, Shawnee State University was named to the Princeton Review's 2011 national list of Top Undergraduate Game Design Programs.
