## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 12, 2011, and as amended on April 13, 2011, Ms. Carolyn Flahive, an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Ohio, filed a motion pursuant to Rule XII, Section 2(A)(6) of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio (Gov. Bar Rules). She seeks the admission pro hac vice of Mr. Kevin Saville to represent Frontier North Inc. in this proceeding.
- (2) The motion states that Mr. Saville is licensed to practice law in the State of Minnesota. The motion further states that, in compliance with Gov. Bar Rule XII(2)(A)(5), Mr. Saville has not been granted permission to appear pro hac vice in more than three proceedings before Ohio tribunals in the current calendar year.
