## EXHIBIT C

AT&T Corp. d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions ("applicant") files this application pursuant to the Commission's January 19, 2011 Entry in Case No. 10-1010-TP-ORD in order to remove from the Commission's records its remaining two-page tariff that was issued and effective January 30, 2009 (See Exhibit A.). It was just brought to the applicant's attention that it should take steps to remove this tariff. Thus, to the extent a waiver of the Entry's April 19, 2011 deadline for such a filing is necessary, one is hereby requested.

The applicant has conferred with the Commission Staff and a consensus was reached that no customer notice is required in connection with this filing. The applicant (under its previous name, Ameritech Advanced Services of Ohio, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions) filed a detariffing application on April 1, 2008 in Case No. 08-371-TP-ATA pursuant to the Commission's September 19, 2007 Entry in Case No. 06-1345-TP-ORD. That filing accomplished the detariffing of all of the applicant's services at that time. The customer notice dated March 14, 2008 that accompanied that application is attached.

Since no additional services remain in the tariff and the only effect of this application is to remove tariff "boilerplate" from the Commission's records, no additional customer notice is necessary and none is being given. In addition, because there will be no remaining tariff pages, there is no Exhibit B to this application.
