In its application, the Company seeks to avail itself of the authority set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 4809.172 to collect a mointhly system improvement charge on all metered and fire service customers. The purpose of the surcharge is to recover costs incurred related to replacement of certain qualifying infrastructure improvements, totaling over \$198,788, to its water distribution system since the last rate increase or system improvement charge approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, The application, if granted in full, will result in an additional \$1.13 per month for an average residential customer using 3,800 gallons of water per month. The proposed surcharge would equal three percent of the total water service bill of each customer and customers can contact the applicant toll-free at 877-987-2782 with any questions concerning the applicant
