ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 2, 2011, Kegg-Robert-PA-PV-6.9KW (Kegg) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code, (O.A.C.), provides for automatic approval for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, unless the Commission suspends the application within 60 days. Kegg's application was suspended on July 1, 2011.
- (3) On July 29, 2011, Kegg filed a request to withdraw its application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (4) The Commission finds that Kegg's request to withdraw its application is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Kegg's request to withdraw its application be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 11-2551-EL-REN be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.




