## <u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 11, 2010, Greg and Kelly Giegerich, d.b.a. KG Tool, (Complainants) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI). In the complaint, the Complainants allege that CEI wrongly billed Complainants for past electric charges resulting from a billing error.
- (2) On March 31, 2010, CEI filed its answer, variously admitting and denying the allegations of the complaint.
- (3) A prehearing conference was held on July 8, 2010.
- (4) On August 4, 2011, the attorney examiner scheduled this case for hearing on September 15, 2011. However, on August 18, 2011, the Complainants filed a request that the complaint be dismissed.
- (5) The Commission finds that the request for dismissal of the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request for dismissal be granted and that the complaint be dismissed without prejudice. It is, further,
